About the Donald K. Rhine Scholarship Program

The Donald K. Rhine Scholarship program was started in 1998 to honor the legacy of Reliant Credit Union's founder, Donald K. Rhine. Each year through this program, Reliant awards several college scholarships valued up to \$3,000 to high school seniors and college students who exemplify the credit union's "people helping people" philosophy. Since the program's inception, Reliant has awarded over \$239,000 in scholarships.

Applying for the 2024 Donald K. Rhine Scholarship

To be considered for a scholarship, you must:

- Be a Reliant member (holding an account in your name). If you are not a Reliant member, call 800-724-9282 or visit our website, reliantcu.com/join, to see if you are eligible to join.
- Be a high school senior, a currently enrolled full-time college/university student, or an adult enrolled or enrolling as a full-time college/university student in the 2024-2025 school year.
- Demonstrate the credit union philosophy of "people helping people."
- Play an active role in your community through community service.
- Demonstrate high achievement in your academic performance and activities.
- Complete and provide required documentation for your application.

Application Submission and Deadline

- Application deadline is February 9, 2024.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 30, 2024.
- Completed scholarship applications must be submitted electronically or returned via mail:
